



ACCESS FACILITIES – INSIDE THE EVENT

Please note: There are limited hard standing paths in Victoria Park. The stages are all on grass. In the event of bad weather, it is likely that mud and puddles will form.



Ticket Types and Collection

The Accessible Areas are outside with very little shade or protection from rain so please come prepared.

Personal Assistant Pass for Viewing Platform and Ground Level Viewing Area at the Main Stage

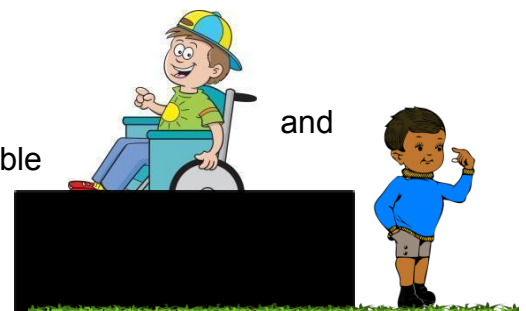
PA Passes can be collected from the **Access Info Point** at the event by showing a ticket and proof of disability. The Access Info Point is located at **First Aid & Welfare**.



PA passes can be swapped with other members of a group.

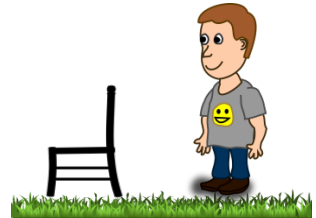
Viewing Platform at the Main Stage

The Viewing Platform is designed for wheelchair users other impairment groups for whom standing is not suitable (subject to availability)



Ground Level Viewing Area at the Main Stage

The Ground Level Viewing is for customers who have access needs but wish to stand, need a less crowded area and/or the option of sitting for short periods of time. (Subject to availability)



Viewing Platform at the 2nd Stage

An unreserved place on the Viewing Platforms at the 2nd stage and valid with proof of disability. (Subject to availability)



Blue Badge Parking

Free of charge and limited to one per paying customer. (Subject to availability). Blue Badge Parking tickets must be booked in advance. You can do this when you buy your event ticket.

Blue Badge Parking tickets are valid with presentation of a blue badge, matching Photo ID and event ticket.

There is no exit from the car park between 8:30pm and 11:45pm.



Facilities

1. Entrance

There is a dedicated accessible lane at the main entrance at Crown Gate, on Grove Road.

2. Access Manager

You can find the Access Manager at **First Aid & Welfare**. This will be clearly signposted.



3. Accessible Toilets

Accessible toilets are at all toilet blocks, First Aid & Welfare and the Viewing Platforms.



There will be a Changing Places Unit (HDU) situated by the Main Stage Viewing Platform.

4. Charging Points for Power Chairs

These are available at the Main Stage Viewing Platform and at First Aid & Welfare.



5. Lowered Counters

There will be lowered counters where possible at the box office, bars, merchandise stands, and some food outlets. Provisions will be made where they are not available.

6. British Sign Language (BSL) Performance Interpreters

BSL Performance Interpreters are available to request for all acts on the Main Stage. Please send requests to access@lidofestival.co.uk



7. Hearing (Induction) Loops

These are located at one of the Box Office windows, First Aid & Welfare and limited bars locations.



8. Merchandise

Merchandise can be produced in alternative formats within a reasonable time frame. Please email your request to access@lidofestival.co.uk



9. Quiet space



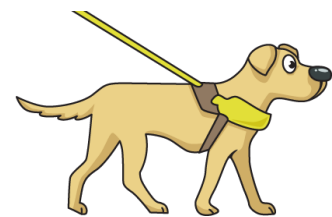
This is a space that people can use when they need to get away from the crowd for a while. It is located at First Aid & Welfare.

Medication

All medication must be clearly labeled as prescribed and the name on the prescription label must match that of the ticket holder

Strobe Lighting & Pyro

Please note that it is likely that most acts performing at the event will use strobe lighting and pyrotechnics as part of their performance.
